

SYMPTOMS	COVID-19	ALLERGIES	COLD	FLU
<b>Fever</b>	Common (100°F or higher)	No	Rare	High (100-102°F) can last 3-4 days
<b>Headache</b>	Sometimes	Sometimes	Rare	Intense
<b>General aches, pains</b>	Sometimes	No	Slight	Common, often severe
<b>Fatigue, weakness</b>	Sometimes	Sometimes	Slight	Common, often severe
<b>Extreme exhaustion</b>	Sometimes (progresses slowly)	No	Never	Common, starts early
<b>Stuffy nose</b>	Rare	Common	Common	Sometimes
<b>Sneezing</b>	Rare	Common	Common	Sometimes
<b>Sore Throat</b>	Sometimes	No	Common	Common
<b>Cough</b>	Common	Sometimes	Mild to moderate	Common, can become severe
<b>Shortness of Breath</b>	In more serious infections	Common	Rare	Rare
<b>Runny nose</b>	Rare	Common	Common	Sometimes
<b>Diarrhea</b>	Sometimes	No	No	Sometimes
<b>New loss of taste, smell</b>	Sometimes	Rare	Rare	No
<b>Chills, shaking</b>	Sometimes	No	Rare	Common
